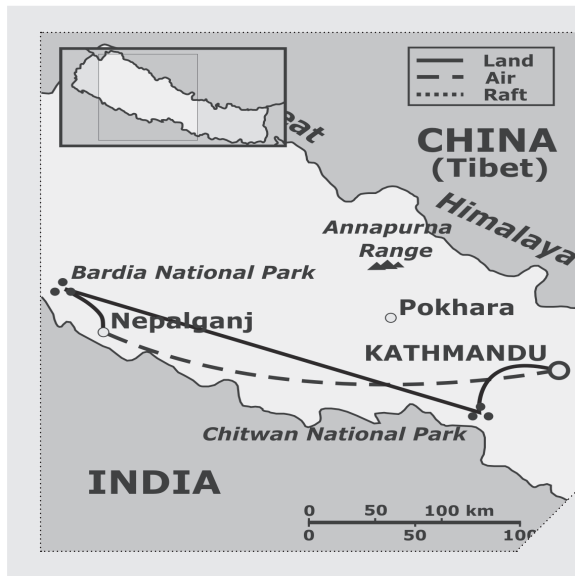

DETAILED ITINERARY

DAY 1 / ARRIVE IN KATHMANDU

We greet you at the airport and transfer you to your hotel in the centre of Kathmandu, where our Nepal Uncovered rep welcomes you, helps you settle in, and explains the agenda for the rest of your tour.

Overnight at hotel in Kathmandu.

DAY 2 / KATHMANDU, TOUR

The first part of the morning will be dedicated to a pre-tour briefing and introduction to your local tour leader. After this we arrange for you to taken on a guided tour of the fascinating, sprawling city of Kathmandu. We start by walking from the tourist centre of Thamel, through winding streets and past corner temples and stupas, to Durbar Square with its splendid array of Hindu Temples and the old Royal Palace. Next, we climb up the many steps leading to the Swayambhunath Stupa, which sits upon a hill overlooking Kathmandu and gives a spectacular view out over the city. In the evening you have an opportunity to try one of the many restaurants and bars, and soak up the unique atmosphere that makes Kathmandu a magnet for travellers from all over the world.

Overnight at hotel in Kathmandu (B).

DAY 3 / NAGARJUN FOREST RESERVE

Today you visit the Nagarjun Forest Reserve on the northern fringes of the Kathmandu Valley. One of the last significant areas of untouched forest in the valley, it is also one of the most popular birdwatching sites in Kathmandu with eagles, thrushes and pheasants all to be found in the area.

Overnight at hotel in Kathmandu (B).

DAY 4 / TRAVEL TO SHREEBAN NATURE CAMP

This morning we leave Kathmandu and after travelling by road (3 hours) followed by a couple of hours walking (jeeps available), we arrive at the Shreeban Nature Camp for spectacular mountain views, and a chance for more birdwatching and easy trekking through the surrounding farmland and forest.

Overnight at lodge in Shreeban Nature Camp (B,L,D).

DAY 5 / SHREEBAN NATURE CAMP

You have a full day to relax and enjoy the surroundings or, if you prefer, choose from a range of excursions including a visit to a local Nalang village for a unique introduction to the culture of the region. Rock climbing and hang gliding can also be arranged for you if you are of a much more active persuasion.

Overnight at lodge in Shreeban Nature Camp (B,L,D).

DAY 6 / DRIVE TO CHITWAN

After breakfast we walk back to the road and then drive to Chitwan National Park. The journey gives you the chance to take in the beautiful scenery which makes Nepal such a popular country to visit. You should arrive at Chitwan in the afternoon and are transferred to your lodge to where we start our safaris with a village and birdwatching walk where you can gain insights into the daily life of the people of this lowland Terai region.

Overnight at safari lodge in Chitwan (B,D).

DAY 7 / CHITWAN NATIONAL PARK

This morning you will hopefully enjoy a beautiful sunrise over the river behind the lodge. You will take a morning elephant back ride into the park in search of the rare, Indian one horned rhino. Travelling on the back of an elephant can be the best way to approach wildlife, especially rhino, as your human smell is obscured by the familiar smell of the elephants themselves. This means that

the animals you search for are much more relaxed in your presence giving you better opportunities to study them.

You also take a canoe ride down the Rapti River, where you have the opportunity to observe the many bird species native to Nepal. You should also see many of the 160 species of migratory birds, which visit Chitwan seasonally. One highlight while on the river is the chance to watch the spectacular skill of ospreys fishing. You may also see Gharial crocodiles sunning themselves on the riverbanks.

After the canoe ride you will explore and learn about the forests in a jungle walk or jeep safari where you should see spotted deer and antelope and hopefully spot some more rhino. Experienced local guides point out the various species, their habitats and behaviour, on all of your journeys into the park. The jeep safaris are not available all the time, but allow you to cover greater distances and explore different habitats as well as visit the crocodile-breeding centre, located deep inside the park.

Your lodge may arrange an optional cultural program one evening.

Overnight at safari lodge in Chiwan (B,L,D).

DAY 8 / DRIVE TO BARDIA NATIONAL PARK

This morning we drive by road, to Bardia National Park, which is about 8 hours drive away. The day's drive takes you through the picturesque forests and farmland of Nepal's lowland Terai region, with the soaring peaks snow-capped peaks of the Himalayas away to the north. We make this a leisurely drive with plenty of stops available to look around, and you can try some local snacks & refreshments. We arrive at the lodge, which is located inside the park boundaries, in the late afternoon. You are at Bardia National Park for four nights and during this time you have an exciting itinerary in and around the park. Once settled into your lodge, you can eat, drink and relax and take in some of the spectacular settings that surround you.

DAY 9-11 / BARDIA NATIONAL PARK

You have three full days to enjoy a range of safari activities in and around the beautiful and tranquil Bardia National Park. The park is situated in the far western Terai, in a remote part of Nepal, east of the Karnali River, and covers an area of 968 sq km. It is about 585 km away from Kathmandu and one of the largest national parks, though one of the least explored by foreigners, making it the largest and most undisturbed wilderness area in the southern part of Nepal. About 70% of the park is covered with predominantly sal forest with a mixture of grassland, savannah and riverine forest. The park's headquarters are situated in Thakurdwara, surrounded by small rural villages inhabited by the indigenous Tharu ethnic group. The park provides an excellent habitat for endangered animals like the rhinoceros, wild elephant (including one of the last known herds of wild elephants in South Asia), tiger, swamp deer, black buck, Gharial crocodile and Gangetic dolphin. Endangered birds include the Bengal florican, silver-eared mesia and Sarus crane. More than 30 different mammals, over 200 species of birds, and many snakes, lizards and fish have been recorded in the park's forest, grassland and river habitats. A good number of resident and migratory birds are also found in the park. Bardia is also the best place in Nepal to see tigers (though sightings still aren't guaranteed).

Whilst at the park you can enjoy, amongst other activities, a jeep safari, easy rafting trip (no white water), elephant ride and guided walks. You can also take time to explore the surrounding Tharu villages and learn more about their traditional way of life. All these activities are included in the tour, but your exact itinerary will be finalised while you are there. Evenings are spent relaxing at your peaceful and secluded safari lodge.

Overnight at safari lodge in Bardia (3xB 3xL 3xD).

DAY 12 / FLY TO KATHMANDU

This morning you drive to Nepalganj (approx. 2-3 hours), stopping

to look for crocodiles from a bridge on the edge of the park. You then board a flight back to Kathmandu (sit on the left side of the plane for good mountain views of the Annapurnas and other peaks). On arrival you are met and transferred to your hotel to enjoy the rest of the day as you wish.

DAY 12 EXTRA OPTIONS

DAY 13 / FREE DAY IN KATHMANDU

Today is a free day to spend relaxing after the previous weeks activities. You may want to spend more time exploring Kathmandu and its surroundings; there are plenty of things to see and do, and great souvenir opportunities

We offer several options today, including a mountain flight up to view Everest, a tour to the nearby ancient centres of Patan and Bhaktapur, or an extension to the tour to try some exciting rafting on the Bhote Khosi river.

Single room supplement

If you want to guarantee yourself a single room throughout the tour, then we need to add a single supplement charge.

If you are a single traveller joining one of our Wildlife Safari group tours, then if you are happy to, you may share a twin room with another single traveller on the tour of the same sex. If there are no other single travellers available for you to pair up with at the time of your booking, then we will need to add the single supplement to your tour price, but will refund this or deduct it from your balance payment if we are able to pair you up later on.

Note: Couples will always be given a private double room, and triple/family rooms are available on request.

Extra days - Price: subject to party make-up

Everest mountain flight option

This flight leaves from Kathmandu early in the morning, and lasts for around an hour, taking you up towards Everest and the surrounding high peaks. You can even get glimpses of the high Tibetan plateau.

The planes have good-sized clear windows, and window seats are guaranteed.

Book & Pay in advance or in Kathmandu.

Kirtipur, Chobar and Pharping tour

This tour visits the historic town of Kirtipur ('City of Glory') which is situated on a hill top ridge and offers panoramic views over the Kathmandu valley. Here you will chance to wander the narrow unpaved lanes and explore the many temples and buildings characterised by Newari architecture. The tour then continues to the town of Chobar, famous for its dramatic gorge and the temple of Adinath Mandir which is adorned with pots, pans and jugs! Finally we visit the settlement of Pharping - a centre for Tibetan Buddhism with a number of gilded *gompa* to see including the famous Pharping Bajra Yogini.

Book & Pay in advance or in Kathmandu.

Patan and Bhaktapur tour

This tour starts by crossing the Bagmati River to nearby Patan, often referred to as Lalitpur 'city of beauty'. Here you will spend plenty of time exploring Durbar Square, which has a fabulous concentration of Buddhist temples. After lunch we drive you out to the ancient city of Bhaktapur, for a tour of the many squares and temples, seeing

stunning wooden architecture as well as exploring the narrow winding lanes which bustle with life. The tour lasts for a full day, and includes private transport and the services of a professional local tour guide. Single person supplements apply.

Book & Pay in advance or in Kathmandu.

Bhote Kosi rafting option - Min 2 people (adds 2 days to the tour)

For those wishing to enjoy some exhilarating white water rafting, this short option takes you to one of Nepal's wildest white water rivers, and one of the best two-day rafting trips in the world. This Grade 4 river (Class -IV to IV+ rapids) is just 3 hours from Kathmandu and makes an excellent adrenaline filled extension to your tour (other easier rivers are available on request).

The minimum age for this option is 16, and you need to be relatively fit and a confident swimmer, and be prepared for continuous, technical, and demanding rapids.

You will be joining a group operated by one of Nepal's premier rafting operators - please contact us to check availability.

ACCOMMODATION:

1. Hotels in Kathmandu

We use a 3 or 4-star tourist class hotel in Kathmandu, which is clean, secure and offers most amenities including a swimming pool. When available we use the Shanker Hotel, a place full of character, which was previously used as a royal palace, but 3-star hotels in the tourist area of Thamel may also be used.

2. Lodge at Shreeban Nature Camp

All double rooms are simply but well furnished with all modern amenities. Bathrooms are available in a separate building and a solar power system provides hot water for showers. The restaurant offers authentic Nepalese, Chinese and continental cuisine. There is also a well stocked bar for guests to enjoy.

3. Safari lodges in Bardia & Chitwan National Parks

At Chitwan National Park, we use safari lodges with comfortable clean rooms and en-suite bathrooms. We normally use lodges in and around the village of Sauraha on the edge of the park, which increases the number of activities you can do while at the park (normally Rhino Lodge).

At Bardia National Park the level of accommodation is a little more basic, and in the traditional Tharu village style. We use a lodge which is using striving to be particularly eco-friendly, and that has

a beautiful setting right in front of the river overlooking the park itself. (Bardia Eco Lodge - www.bardiaecolodge.com). There is good birdwatching from the lodge and you should see monkeys and deer coming to drink on the opposite banks of the river, as well as park elephants passing by the front of the lodge. Rooms are clean and comfortable with mosquito nets. Hot water is available for showers, though this is solar heated so dependent on weather conditions.

TREKKING TO SHREEBAN NATURE CAMP:

This walk takes around 2-3 hours and does require a medium level of fitness. We have plenty of time built into the itinerary and it is an interesting and beautiful walk so there is no need to rush or walk fast. If travelling with a group, you should be prepared to walk at the speed of the slowest member.

We have graded this trek as: **EASY:**

"This is an easy trek, suitable for most people that are either weekend walkers or confident enough to embark on a trek for the stated duration. As long as you are fit and healthy, this trek should present no problems. Altitudes are usually lower than 3,000m, but there may be some steep climbs and descents."

TRANSPORT & TRANSFERS:

We use private cars or minibuses for all the main transfers & journeys on this tour. An internal flight is used for the journey back from Bardia to Kathmandu. A variety of transport including jeeps,

elephants & canoes is used if when you visit both parks.

Upgrades to internal flights are available on request.

Both your airport arrival and departure airport transfers are included (24-hour service).

INTERNATIONAL FLIGHTS:

In order to keep our tours flexible, and to make them accessible to as many people as possible, we do not include your international flights in the set tour itinerary or price.

However, we do hold an ATOL (UK flight sales license) and are happy to book your flights for you. If you let us know your ideal dates and departure airport, then we will be happy to provide you with some flight options that we can arrange for you. You can then choose whether to book the flights through us, or make your own arrangements. Either way, your airport arrival & departure transfers are included.

TOUR GUIDES & ENTRANCE FEES:

We provide a fully trained English-speaking guide to accompany you from the start to the end of your tour, and we use specially trained local safari guides during your stay at Shreeban and Chitwan and Bardia National Parks. Many of our travellers consider travelling with our guides and reps a highlight of their tour.

Entry permits to Bardia & Chitwan National Parks, along with all entry fees during the sightseeing tour in Kathmandu are included.

All national park activity costs are included, to cover one of each of the following in:

- Bardia: Elephant Ride, Jeep Safari, Jungle Walk x2, Village Walk, River rafting trip.
- Chitwan: Elephant Ride, Jeep Safari (when available) Jungle Walk, Village Walk, River canoe trip.

To help support the local people and economy, and because we know it works best, our policy at Nepal Uncovered is to use only local guides and tour leaders on this tour. Please check our website for further details.

MEALS:

Kathmandu:

Breakfasts only are provided in the hotel. Kathmandu has a wealth of restaurants serving excellent food from all over the world, so you will never be short of ideas or places to eat within a short walk of the hotel.

Shreeban, Bardia & Chitwan National Parks:

All meals are included in the lodges restaurants (breakfast, lunch & dinner), covering a range of options, both local and western.

WHEN TO GO:

Monsoon season:

June to mid-September

While we can run this tour during the monsoon, we don't generally recommend it as the weather can be very hot & wet, and the parks hard to explore.

Good viewing:

Mid-September to November

This is an ideal time to visit, as the weather is great, and wildlife viewing is good. As the season progresses, the elephant grass grows taller, which starts to make it harder to spot some wildlife in the parks.

Winter season:

December to February

This is a good time to visit the national parks in Nepal. The weather

is fine, and many migratory birds arrive from December onwards. The elephant grass is getting long however, which cuts down some viewing opportunities.

Best viewing:

March to May:

This is the best time to visit Nepal's National Parks. The annual cut & burn of the elephant grass is done early in this season and this allows for much improved wildlife viewing. It does get hot towards the end of the season in May, and while this brings the animals out to drink, March & April are ideal travelling times.

TIPPING:

While an accepted part of the culture and customs in Nepal, tipping is always optional, and any amounts paid should reflect excellent service. It is normal and accepted for people to tip differently, and you should not feel under any pressure to tip any particular amount.

We are often asked for advice on common amounts however, and suggest that up to approx. 5% of the tour price would be a suitable budget for this tour.

COUNTRY GUIDE:

For an in-depth overview of Nepal, including up-to-date regional security advice and information, please checkout the country guide pages on our website.

DATES & PRICES:

We run several small-group departures during the ideal travelling seasons. These departure dates and prices are listed on our website and on a separate dates & prices sheet available on request. We can also run the set tour itinerary privately for you on other dates, or customise it to make a tailor-made tour to fit your personal requirements.

HEALTH:

Recommended vaccinations and other health protection measures vary according to the country you are visiting, and where you are travelling from. You must obtain professional advice from your medical practitioner or a travel clinic on current vaccinations needed for your destination (1st Contact travel clinic gives free advice tel. 0800 0393073).

In general, most recommendations for Nepal include: Tetanus, Typhoid, Hepatitis A, Polio, Meningitis, Rabies and Malaria prophylactics.

VISAS:

Many nationals can obtain their Nepalese visa in Kathmandu airport upon arrival (including UK, European & US citizens). The cost is US\$25 (UK Pounds also accepted) and the visa is obtained in the immigration area at the point where your passport is stamped (i.e. you don't need to join an extra queue).

RESPONSIBLE TOURISM:

We take responsible travel seriously, and as well as taking this into consideration when we design our itineraries, and select the people and agents we work with, we also donate £2 for every person travelling on of our Nepalese tours. This is split between two projects:

- Shree Nalang primary school, which is situated 80km NW of Kathmandu and caters for 5-11 year old children. Our donations are helping with renovations and building of new classrooms.
- Bardia eco lodge. Our directors are involved in supporting the building
